ENTRY FORM DEADLINE: Tuesday, December 9, 2008

Deliver entries to the Folsom Community Center, Wednesday, January 30, between 7:00 and 9:00 a.m.

RULES

1. FQFG members may enter quilts, wearable art, and other fiber items that they have made or have participated in making.
2. An active member may also sponsor, for exhibit only, one item made or owned by a non-member.
3. Entries may not have been shown previously in a FQFG Show.
4. Maximum number of entries per person **is two in any one class**, up to a **total of four** items across all classes. **EXCEPTION:** Members may enter a limit of **1 entry in each of the guild challenges in addition to the limit of 4**. An item may be reassigned to a more appropriate class after review of entry form or by request of judges.
5. The number of entries may need to be limited due to hall size.
6. Members may enter items either for **Exhibit Only** or for **Professional Judging**.
 - a. Members' Exhibit Only items may be of any vintage. There is no fee to enter these items.
 - b. Member must have completed the items for Professional Judging within the last **three (3)** years. There is a \$10.00 fee for each judged entry.
 - c. Professional judging is not available for sponsored items.
7. Each quilt will be insured at a value of \$500.00. If additional insurance is desired, it will be the responsibility of the member to arrange with the quilt show committee for private payment of each desired \$500.00 increment.
8. A **completed** entry form, a **photo of the item** is required for each entry. Also, please enclose a photo of the maker and/or exhibitor not to exceed 3"x 5"to:

Judged items only: Include a \$10 check payable to Folsom Quilt & Fiber guild for each item judged. We will send you an acknowledgement of your entry by January 20, 2009.

9. Awards and Ribbons
 - a. Judged Entries: Judges may award 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Honorable Mention ribbons in each judged **category listed below**.
 - b. Judges may award a Judge's Choice to any judged entry.
 - c. Judges may award a Best Use of Color to any judged entry.
 - d. Judges may award a Best Hand Quilting award to any judged entry.
 - e. Judges may award a Best Machine Quilting award to any judged entry.
 - f. All Junior quilts receive participation ribbons and complementary evaluations.
 - g. All entries, **including sponsored** items, are eligible for the Members' Choice and Viewers' Choice Awards
